#	Boundary Name	Between Countries	Significance / Year
1	Radcliffe Line	India and Pakistan	Drawn by Sir Cyril Radcliffe in 1947; Partition boundary
2	McMahon Line	India and China	Defined in 1914 (Simla Agreement); associated with Arunachal Pradesh
3	Durand Line	Pakistan and Afghanistan	Established in 1893 by Sir Mortimer Durand; disputed at times
4	Maginot Line	France and Germany	French defensive fortifications built before WWII
5	Siegfried Line	Germany and France	German defensive line opposite the Maginot Line (WWII)
6	38th Parallel	North Korea and South Korea	Dividing line after WWII and Korean War; DMZ around it
7	49th Parallel	USA and Canada	Established as boundary by Treaty of 1818
8	Hindenburg Line	Germany and Allied Fronts	German defensive line during World War I
9	Oder-Neisse Line	Germany and Poland	Post-World War II boundary (1945)
10	Mason-Dixon Line	USA (historical regional line)	Historical demarcation between northern and southern states
11	Blue Line	Israel and Lebanon	Defined by UN in 2000 for border demarcation
12	Green Line	Israel and neighboring Arab areas	1949 Armistice Line after Arab-Israeli war
13	Curzon Line	Poland and the former Soviet Union	Proposed by Lord Curzon after WWI; historical significance
14	24th Parallel (claimed)	India and Pakistan (disputed claim)	Line claimed by Pakistan; not internationally recognized

15	Purple Line	Syria and Israel (post-1973)	Boundary adjustments after 1973 Yom Kippur War
16	Line of Control (LoC)	India and Pakistan (Jammu & Kashmir)	Ceasefire line established after 1971 Indo-Pak conflict
17	Line of Actual Control (LAC)	India and China	De facto border separating Indian and Chinese-controlled areas
18	Mannerheim Line	Finland and Russia	Defensive fortifications built by Finland before WWII
19	17th Parallel	North and South Vietnam	Dividing line during Vietnam War era (1954-1976)
20	Iron Curtain	Eastern and Western Europe	Political boundary during the Cold War era between USSR bloc and the West
